What is the program and what are the benefits?



The **c.i.a.o. program** provides a valuable link between the Italian seniors in residential care and the wider community. The **c.i.a.o. program** facilitators bring all the Italian residents together in a group setting - on site - to share morning tea, music and Italian cultural past-times. The program aims to provide activities that are an added feature to any mainstream facility.

Co.As.It. has provided valuable support services to residential facilities since 2005, by implementing the **c.i.a.o. program** for residents of Italian background. Our trained and qualified staff have a richness of life experience with many different linguistic and cultural competencies and above all, a genuine sense of caring about others.

The provision of the **c.i.a.o. program** is vitally important for Italian elderly because they often cannot engage with activities at the centre and consequently suffer isolation and marginalization. The **c.i.a.o. program** enriches the quality of life for elderly Italians who often cannot participate in the facility's diversion therapy activities because of lack of English language skills, cognitive impairment and cultural differences. It is encouraging to see that even those residents with dementia still show happiness and direct responses when they hear Italian voices, Italian music and smell Italian coffee.

The CIAO Program is a not for profit offering. Co.As.It. Community Services offers the two hour **c.i.a.o. program** for \$120 plus GST. It is exceptional value.
